

**MEMORANDUM
OF
MUTUAL SUPPORT**

WHEREAS, The National Episcopal Scouters Association, Inc. and the Boy Scouts of America desire to establish and maintain a collaborative relationship on behalf of Episcopal boys, young adults, adults, families and congregations, we now enter into this agreement for the purpose of confirming a framework for a cooperative relationship under which the National Episcopal Scouters Association and the Boy Scouts of America will assist one another in areas of mutual objectives, and

WHEREAS, "It is the mission of the Boy Scouts of America to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law," and

WHEREAS, The Boy Scouts of America is desirous of lending its aid and support to the citizenship, character development, and personal fitness of boys and young men and women through community-based organizations, and

WHEREAS, It is the mission of the National Episcopal Scouters Association to provide support to Episcopal youth, adults, and congregations that elect to be a part of the Boy Scout program, and

WHEREAS, National Episcopal Scouters Association is desirous of administering a religious emblems program for Episcopal youth and adults to increase an understanding of their faith and duty to others, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the National Episcopal Scouters Association and the Boy Scouts of America will work with each other within the rules and regulations of the Boy Scouts of America to establish and nurture Scout units as an expression of the mission of the National Episcopal Scouters Association and to administer a religious emblems program for Episcopal youth and adults so that they may grow in character, citizenship responsibility, and with the personal fitness necessary to achieve their greatest potential.
