The Venturing Leadership Award (VLA) can be presented at the council, Area, Regional, and National level to outstanding youth. A council can present two awards for youth members per year for up to 50 crews/ships, and one additional youth recognition per year for each fraction of 25 crews/ships above 50. The Area, Regional, and National level can present up to 8 VLAs per year.

While you're on vacation, maybe it's time to start thinking about what you want to do next year. Have you considered applying for a youth officer position? There are President and Vice President positions available on the crew, district, council, area, regional and national level. Speaking from experience, there

is nothing like being a youth officer! Even just at the crew level, it is really encouraging to have that responsibility of having your crew depend on you. Of course, this responsibility increases as you move from crew to district to council, and so on. However, you also have the opportunity to even greater affect the Venturing program. Depending on your position, you have the ability to directly effect yourself and those around you, all the way to hundreds or even thousands of Venturers.

To give you an idea of some of the special opportunities that coincide with youth officer positions, please don't hesitate to e-mail (president@crventuring.org). I would be more than happy to tell you about travelling to 4 BSA camps, visiting 5 states, flying on 8 planes, writing 5 newsletter articles, reading at least 15 quarterly reports, attending 2 major meetings, and enough e-mails to make my head spin. Included was the chance to go to Philmont for a National Volunteer Training Committee meeting, and to attend two area fun events to talk to Venturers about their program, and to just have fun with them! Believe it or not, that's all just since September!

You can also talk to any other youth officer (a link to e-mail all members of the region VOAs can be found on their page at crventuring.org).

If you are interested in a position at council or district levels, please talk to your council or district. If your council or district does not have a VOA, think about starting one! Applications are now being accepted for the position of National, Regional and Area Venturing Presidents and Vice-Presidents for the 2013-2014 term of office. All submissions are due by **February 1**, 2013 for National Venturing President, **February 15**, 2013 for Region Venturing President and Vice-President positions, and **March 1**, 2013 for Area Venturing President and Vice-President positions. For more information about these positions and minimum qualifications, please refer to the Venturing Standard Operating Procedures available at: http://www.scouting.org/Venturing. The application is available at http://www.crventuring.org/document2.php?s=1&id=644. I sincerely hope you all will apply for a youth position!

Venturing is a Scouting program for male and female youth ages 13-21 that lets youth experience new activities, build leadership skills, earn awards, make new friends, and of course have fun.
