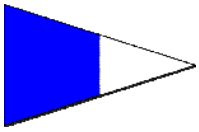


Answer (Affirmative)

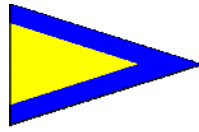
DAY-SEE-MAL
